### Single:

- Article "3": Each answer has the word three in it
  - Our resolution for debate was based on Article 3 of the Consitution
- Sweep the leg: Each answer is a movie quote
  - Sweep the leg is an inside team joke
- "Tim": Each answer contains "tim". For example: Timid
- Michaels: Each answer is a famous Michael
- Tim Michaels: Trivia about Tim
  - Our debate coach!

### Double:

- Dayton? Let's go somewhere better: Each answer is a city
  - Dayton is the city we were going to
- If Tim was writing: Answers contain no vowels
  - Our coach is notorious for leaving vowels out of words to write faster
- On a first-name basis: Answers are portions of a team member's first name. For example: Brayden, answer: ray
- PSU - more like Penn State University: Answers are the full name of common abbreviations
  - Penn State is where we go to school
- First Timers: Answers have to do with the first time something was ever done/accomplished
  - Many of the debaters on the team were new
